DIVERSITY POLICY

At 'Designer Makers Market' we aim to make our events inclusive, diverse and fair. We also aim to ensure that everyone who visits or takes part in our events feels welcome and safe.

We aim to promote individuality and originality and are passionate about supporting all talented artists including those from underrepresented groups. These are curated events and whilst most artists/makers are invited to take part we are always open to accepting artists/makers who approach us as long as their work 'fits the criteria'. It is very important that we always have a good 'mix' of mediums at the events so people may be turned away because there is no space for their particular medium not because their work isn't suitable.

We work hard to make sure our events are attractive to our customers and therefore aim each year to have at least 30% of the artists/makers taking part 'new' to that venue. The events are relatively small, with a maximum of thirty exhibitors at each venue, who demonstrate a wide variety of skills and products.

We aim to introduce new and emerging talent and our application/selection process and involvement opportunities are entirely without prejudice. Stallholders, tutors and visitors are all treated equally regardless of age, disability, gender, race, ethnicity, religious belief, sexuality or social/economic status. We believe that everyone is entitled to enjoy our events and activities free from threat of intimidation, harassment and abuse.

We welcome feedback both from stallholders and visitors, listen to comments/suggestions after each event and do our best to keep the events improving.
